On Tuesday, May 19, 2020, Deda Kenyon, a loving wife, mother, grandmother, passed away at the age of 76.

Deda Delene (Tait) Kenyon was born in January of 1944 and lived in Wenatchee, Washington, where she spent her youth active in civic activities and worked at the Elks club until her marriage to her high school sweetheart Tom Kenyon. Together for more than 60 years (married for 54 years), they had a son Christian, who died shortly after birth, and two daughters, Nicole and Kristina.

After college in Ellensburg, Deda and Tom moved to California to start their family. They lived in Martinez and Pleasant Hill, Calif. for more than 30 years but often spent summers in Chelan. During their years together, they also lived in Texas, traveled to Hong Kong and Paris, and most recently spent their retirement in Paso Robles. Deda was an accountant and office manager, she was active in the local Women's club and PTA, but she will be most remembered not for any positions she held, but for her humor and outgoing personality that touched everyone she met. She loved her family unconditionally and was a model in how to deal with life's struggles with grace and a smile.

Deda is survived by her husband Thomas James Kenyon, her mother Beatrice Tait, sister Della Brett, two daughters Nicole Kenyon Guntharp and Kristina Kenyon and grandson, Patrick Thomas Kenyon Guntharp.


