



Lawrence "Larry" H. Scharps

October 6, 1930 - June 23, 2018

Larry Scharps, 87, of Wenatchee, WA passed away on June 23, 2018. He was born on October 6, 1930 to Helen Scharps and Lawrence H. Scharps, Sr. in Los Angeles, CA where he was raised. He graduated from L.A. High School in 1948 and then went on to L.A. City College to study psychology for two years. In 1950, he found a job at North American Aviation assembling airplane parts and worked there for two years. He was then drafted into the U.S. Army during the Korean War and served from 1952 to 1954 at Fort Ord near Monterey, CA. After an honorable discharge from the army, Larry enrolled at UCLA in 1957. During this time, he met his wife Neomah. They got married in 1958 after he graduated with a bachelor's degree in psychology. He worked as a social worker at L.A. County General Hospital until he retired in 1982. Larry and Neomah moved to Wenatchee in 1983. He stayed active as a member of WRAC and enjoyed playing tennis and working out. He also loved bicycling, gardening, going to the theater and reading. Larry's happiest moments were spent hiking with friends on the numerous, beautiful trails in Chelan County. He is survived by his wife Neomah, daughter Laureen and son-in-law Gernot. The Celebration of Larry's Life will be held on Monday, July 2, 2018 at 11:00 am at Grace Lutheran Church on Washington St. The burial will take place at Wenatchee Cemetery the same day at 10:00 am.
