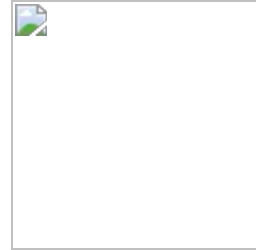
A family/friends memorial service will be held at a later date.
