One of her greatest joys were her grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

She was active in her church throughout her life in whatever role she could serve, be it Sunday school teacher, song leader, or usher. For two years, she enjoyed her role as Apple Blossom Festival royalty chaperone. Along with her

sister, Cathy, she stepped into the business world of retail, by opening a ladies boutique called "The Rag Doll".

In their years together, Audrey and Bob enjoyed trips overseas, boating adventures, family reunions, and time at Lake Chelan. But always, their favorite place was coming back home to Wenatchee.
