Camille Nelson Viebrock, 78, passed away at her home in Waterville on November 27, 2023. She was born August 27, 1945 in Waterville, WA. After graduating from Waterville High School in 1963 she and her sweetheart, Denny Viebrock, moved to Spokane where she attended Kinman Business College and worked for a short time. They then moved back to Waterville where they got married in the Douglas Lutheran Church on June 4, 1966 and settled one mile south of Waterville where she lived until her death.

Camille and Denny farmed for a time and raised two children, Cryss (Viebrock) Toycen and Chad Viebrock. Camille worked for part-time for the Mitchell's Pharmacy and then for Nelson's Dry Goods before moving on the ASCS office in Waterville. In 1985 she then went on to work for Central Washington Grain Growers (now Highline Grain Growers) until her retirement in 2011. Being a lifelong resident of the Waterville Plateau, Camille's knowledge of farming, the farming community, and the farming families helped her excel at her job and it was evident in the care that

she took with every
phone call, question and need.

Camille loved her family, home, and church. She loved planting her deck pots with flowers in the spring to enjoy all summer long and to adorn the family gravestones for the Memorial Holiday. She served in many functions at the church from providing and serving refreshments after church services on Sunday, to helping in the kitchen for other events and services and spent many hours making quilts to donate to many charitable organizations. She was a wonderful mom and proud grandma and great grandma.

Camille is preceded in death by her parents Neil L. and Myrna K. Nelson and her husband of 49 years,

Denny Viebrock. She is survived by her sister, Carmen Nelson (Neil P), daughter, Cryss. Toycen (Jeff) and son, Chad; 2 grandsons, Jake Toycen (Ashleigh) and Doug Viebrock, and 2 great grandchildren, Knox & Logan Toycen (Jake).
