



## Carmen D. Thurber

Carmen Doreen Thurber, age 94, a resident of Wenatchee for seven years, and a former resident of Arcata, California went to be with the Lord on Thursday, April 4, 2019.

She was raised in Beresford, South Dakota. Carmen met her husband, Danny M. Thurber in Walla Walla, Washington. They worked together at the Ship Building Docks in Vanport, Oregon during World War II.
