Charles Daniel Hart was born on October 23, 1931, in Manchester, England. He passed away at Highline Care Center in East Wenatchee on Friday, July 23, 2010. Dan grew up in Southport and attended schools in the northwest of England. He was in the Royal Air Force and eventually joined the family textile business in Wigan, England. In 1953, he married Wendy (Grierson) of Southport, and they resided in the United Kingdom and raised two daughters. In 1980, Dan and Wendy moved to the United States and started a business importing antiques. Later, Dan built a concession trailer, a replica of a boat from which he sold traditional fish and chips and seafoods. Hart's Flying Fish travelled throughout Washington State and participated at fairs, rodeos and ball games. In 1987, he opened Hart's Fish and Chips on Wenatchee Avenue and enjoyed working and making friends with many customers and staff. He retired in 1999 due to ill health.

Dan is survived by two daughters, Susana Jane (Andrew) Foster of Parbold, England and Carol Ann (Bruce) Schneller of Waterville. He

has two grandsons, Daniel and James Foster of Parbold, England; and several nephews and nieces. He was preceded in death by his wife, Wendy, in 1999; and a sister, Jose Lee in 2010.
