



Charles D Peters

October 9, 1927 - June 16, 2014

Charles "Chuck" Dale Peters, 86, of Wenatchee, WA passed away on Monday, June 16, 2014. He was born October 9, 1927 in Wenatchee, Washington to Charles Melvin and Iva Diantha (Inks) Peters. He attended school in Sunnyslope, graduating from Wenatchee High School in 1945. In June 1945, he entered the Merchant Marine Training School at Catalina Island, California where he finished advanced training in late summer as the war ended. After a voyage to the Philippine Islands, he returned to Wenatchee, and in May of 1946 enlisted in the U.S. Army Signal Corps. He received his Basic Training at Camp Polk, Louisiana and was then sent to Fort Monmouth, New Jersey where he attended the Signal School. In the spring of 1947, he was sent to Germany, serving with the 7772 Signal Battalion as a Central Office Technician at the Frankfurt Military Telephone Office. He was honorably discharged in 1949, returning to Wenatchee. He worked at various jobs until 1952 when he was employed by Alcoa working as a maintenance foreman until 1967. That year he accepted employment with the Washington State Department of Transportation as an Electronics Technician, continuing with the department until his retirement in 1993. In April, 1951 he married Mayme Ellen Vaughn of Cashmere. After living in Spokane and Yakima, they returned to Wenatchee in July 1952 where they had four children, Mary Ellen (Peters) Blankenship, Carolyn Dianne (Peters) Loss, Robert Charles Peters, and John Franklin Peters. He had 5 grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his father in 1959, his mother and a sister in 1994.
