Clinton Heuett, a long time resident of Wenatchee since 1964 passed away on Feb 3,2011 on his 87th birthday after a long illness.

Clinton was born Feb 3, 1924 in Jacques Spur, Idaho to George and Lena Heuett. Clinton began working in Tacoma Shipyards at age 16 prior to WWII. He joined the US Army in 1941, served in Hawaii and Italy during WWII. After the war, he returned to Lewiston, Idaho where he met and soon married Betty Adamson in Feb 1947. He worked as a house builder in partnership with his older brothers for a few years in Lewiston, Idaho. He later worked as a millwright/welder throughout the Pacific Northwest on various projects including the hydroelectric dams all up the Columbia River. In 1972 he started working at Alcoa and retired in 1991 after 19 years. Clinton and Betty's union blessed them with six sons, Richard of Snohomish, WA, Steven of Quilcene, WA, Wayne of East Wenatchee, WA, Monte of Selah, WA and Kelly of Sun Valley, Idaho. Scott preceded Clinton in death in 1994 and his wife Betty passed away in 2004. Clinton also had 15 grandchildren and 12 great grandchildren. Clinton shared the last of his treasured years with his partner Ruth Rushmore until his passing. Clinton's passions in life were fishing and hunting in the outdoors. He also loved playing pinochle and cribbage card games and played frequently at the Wenatchee Senior Center. He was also a frequent participant in the dances held at the Senior Center.
