Daniel Clair Lenarth, 86, passed away on Tuesday, May 11, 2010, in Wenatchee, WA. Daniel was born to Clarence and Margaret Lenarth on March 9, 1924, in Gardena, CA. He was the middle child of five, with two older brothers and two younger sisters. Daniel served his country by joining the Navy in July 1941, and was stationed in both the United States and the Solomon Islands during World War II. He achieved the rank of Aviation Chief Ordinanceman, before being honorably discharged in March 1947. Daniel worked in California for Bell (now AT&T) Telephone Company for over 30 years, and then retired to East Wenatchee, WA, where he enjoyed 20 years of retirement.
