Daryl Brian Kirby, 70 of Wenatchee, WA died peacefully in his sleep January 24th, 2018 in his home. He was born November 23rd, 1947 to Jack and Gwen Kirby in Wenatchee WA. He grew up on an orchard in Squilchuck, graduating from Wenatchee High School in 1966. After a brief stint in the Navy, he attended Wenatchee Valley College. He married Vivian Balyeat, on August 29th, 1970 in Wenatchee. After working several jobs in construction and carpentry and pursuing a degree in aviation, he joined his father in working on the family orchard in the mid-seventies. He spent the next 30 years working the family orchard before retiring in 2007.

Every fall he looked forward spending time at elk camp with his father, uncle and cousin, and later in life his children and grandchildren. In the summer months, you could find him relaxing at Lake Chelan on most weekends boating and fishing. Hawaii became his favorite destination later in life, and he would spend several weeks in Maui every winter.

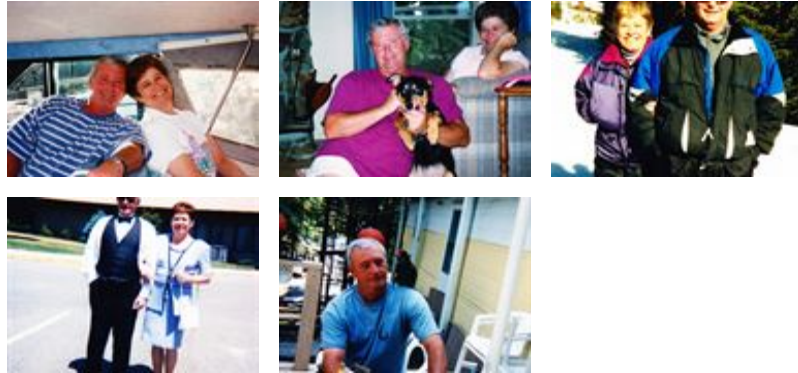
