



## Dennis G. Viebrock

May 5, 1942 - September 20, 2015

Denny Viebrock, 73, passed away at his home on September 20, 2015. He was born on May 5, 1942 to Henry C. (Chuck) and Martha (Grande) Viebrock of Waterville, WA. He was a lifetime resident of Waterville, graduating from Waterville High School in 1960 then enlisting in the U.S. Navy in 1961. Denny served on the U.S.S. Saratoga and the U.S.S. Canberra finishing his tour of duty at U.S. Naval Station Treasure Island in San Francisco, CA.

On June 4, 1966, he married the love of his life Camille (Nelson) Viebrock in the Lutheran Church in Douglas, WA. He then settled into small town farm life as a 4-H leader, NCW fair board member, United Lutheran Church council and call committee member. Denny supported his family through farming and other occupational endeavors.

After 28 years as a truck driver/warehouseman at Central Washington Gran Growers, Inc., Denny retired in 2008. He spent most of the years of his retirement enjoying his horses and helping his brother, Sid Viebrock, and other ranchers on the plateau and Badger Mountain with their cattle.
