March 4, 1923 - March 20, 2018

Don Oliver Danner, age 95, was born in Wenatchee, WA on March 4, 1923 to Roy Allen Danner and Eva Pearl Herren Danner. He died March 20, 2018 at Wenatchee, WA. He attended Wenatchee Schools and graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1941.

In 1942 he joined the U.S. Navy and was honorably discharged in late 1945. He returned to Wenatchee in 1950 and started a retail milk delivery business which lasted until 1958 when he sold out to Foremost Dairies. He leased a Shell Service Station on South Wenatchee Avenue for two years. In 1960 he went to work for the Chelan County Sheriff Office as a Deputy Sheriff. He became a detective and in 1970 went to school and became a Polygraph examiner. He retired in 1984.

He loved to sing and belonged to the Apollo Club in past years; in recent years, singing with the Wenatchee Valley Senior Activity Center Singers. He was a league bowler, a member of the Elks, Eagles, American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and was a board member of the Washington State Deputy Sheriff & Police Officer Association.

In 1950 he married Erna Zitzer Joseph in Chicago and they raised two daughters. In 1970 he married Margaret Mary Freaney in East Wenatchee. He was preceded in death by his parents and brother, Bob. He is survived by his wife Margaret, daughter Bonnie Brawley (husband, Don) and daughter Donna Madison (husband, Ron).
