Don E. Holland, 59, passed away peacefully, surrounded by his family on January 27, 2018 after a brief illness.

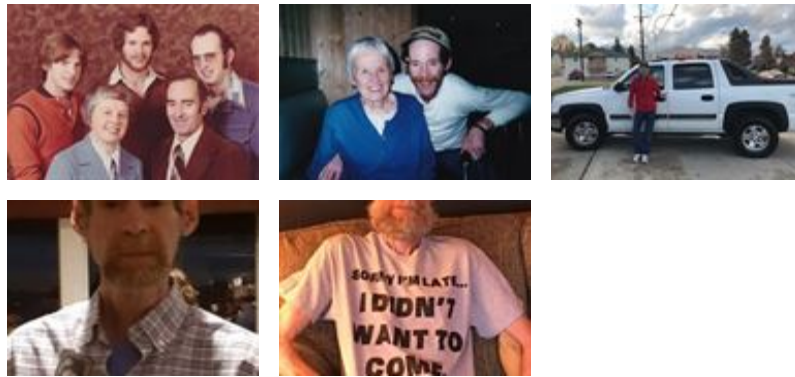
