February 25, 1932 - January 20, 2018

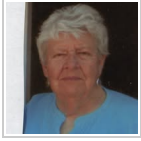
Don Whiting passed away on January 20", 2018 following a short illness. Don was born on February 25, 1932 in Brewster, Washington to Robert and Lorrita Whiting. He grew up in Brewster, graduating from Brewster High School in 1950. He married Thelma Walker in 1950, and during their marriage they lived primarily in Wenatchee, where he worked for the Chelan County PUD.

Don married Clara Cobb in 1967, and they moved to Anchorage, Alaska where both were employed with the Telephone Division of the Alaska Public Utilities. After retirement, they returned to the Wenatchee Valley, and used it as a base from which they traveled extensively. Life on the road was a huge part of their early retirement years. Don was preceded in death by his wife Clara, his parents, his sister Kay Hyde, his brother Ellsworth Hyde, and his stepdaughter Marie Cobb.
