Doss Payne, Jr. born July 7, 1936 to Doss Payne, Sr. and Eva Bryant Payne in Okanogan, WA, died January 1, 2015. Doss attended Orondo Grade School, East Wenatchee Junior High and Wenatchee High School. He then joined the U. S. Navy. He attended basic training in San Diego, CA. Upon completion of basic training, he attended the Seabee's Construction School at Port Hueneme, CA. The Seabee motto, "Can Do" was very important to him. He served a year in Adak, Alaska and two tours in the Phillipines. He married Ella Jane Fenton October 1, 1955. Doss owned and operated a cabinet shop in Waterville until joining the Wenatchee Police Department in 1963. He then joined the Chelan County Sheriff's Office, serving as Chief Criminal Deputy. He also worked for the Port of Seattle Police Department and served as Chief of Police for the City on Snoqualmie. He attended many law enforcement schools and the FBI Academy in Quantico, Virginia. After law enforcement, Doss enjoyed construction – new and remodeling. There are many family memories of camping, fishing and hunting trips.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Ella Jane. Two children – Laura Phillips & Rex (Laurie) Payne. 6 grandchildren- Melissa, Michelle, Mindy, Matthew, Andrew and Nicole. 3 sisters, Marvel (Dave) Mires, Waterville, Myrna Smith, Wenatchee and Diane (Al) Hansen, Irrigon, Oregon. He was preceded in death by his parents, Doss, Sr. and Eva and his beloved brother, Giles.
