Duane Daling, 80, of Waterville, passed away at Central Washington Hospital on January 30, 2017 as a result of a long battle with heart disease.

Duane was born to Carl and Laura Daling of Waterville Washington on July 27, 1936. He was a lifelong resident of Waterville and graduated from Waterville High School in 1955. He was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1956 and was discharged from active duty in 1958. After leaving the service, he joined his family, farming with his parents and brothers on the family farm.
