



Edward Ray Triesch

September 28, 1922 - July 22, 2016

Edward Ramond “Ray” Triesch passed away on July 22, 2016, at Colonial Vista Assisted Living, at the age of 93. He was born September 28, 1922 in Prosser, WA., to Edward J. and Louise (LaPlante) Triesch. Ray joined the Washington National Guard in 1939, and he mobilized for WWII. Ray was among the first infantry battalions overseas to the South Pacific Islands. For the duration of the war (with the exception of 13 days in the continental U.S.), he spent his entire service overseas. He was promoted to Second Lieutenant “in the field”, at Luzon, Phillipine Islands. It was in this location he had the privilege of seeing General Douglas McArthur. Ray was awarded several medals and ribbons, but the one he treasured most was the “Sharp-Shooter” badge.

Ray was an avid bowler, and he was also an avid walker, seven days a week! He also enjoyed cross word puzzles and bird watching. Ray belonged to the American Legion, in Aberdeen, WA and the Eagles, in Wenatchee.

In his retirement, Ray served as an Assistant Secretary of the Knife and Fork Club in Wenatchee. He belonged to the Senior Center Activities Program and had been active in R.S.V.P., as well a Council on Aging driver for the Meals on Wheels program.

Ray is survived by one brother, Richard Triesch, of Sumner, WA and one

sister, Mary Worley, of Elk, WA; a son, Tim Triesch (spouse, Rebecca) and grandchildren: Jeremy, Krystyn, Jemma, Spencer Triesch, and Andrew Franich and great-grandson, Zander Triesch; a daughter, Teresa Furstenwerth (spouse, Dave) and granddaughters, Kelsey and Haley Furstenwerth.

Ray was preceded in death by his parents, 3 brothers, one sister and one son, Danny. There will be a viewing at 8:30 a.m. at Jones & Jones – Betts Funeral Home, with a graveside service to follow at the Wenatchee Cemetery at 10:00 on Friday, July 29th , 2016.
