She attended nursing school in Spokane, however, Betty came home to marry Oscar A. Nollmeyer and raise a family. Betty enjoyed wheat harvest and deer hunting with Oscar. She was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church in East Wenatchee and Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Withrow. In 1959, she moved with Oscar and children to Brays Landing where they owned and operated an apple and pear orchard. After she raised son, Keith and daughter Joy, she returned to nursing school and graduated. She worked as an LPN for Lake Chelan Community Hospital for over twenty years.

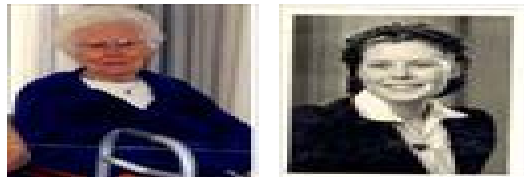
