Ethel Martha Buscher Brandt was born in Ritzville, WA on January 18, 1914 to Lena and Frederick Buscher. She passed away suddenly on September 14, 2011. She attended a rural school at Tokio, Wa for 8 years and graduated from Ritzville High School as class valedictorian in 1932.

On April 26, 1944 she was married to John W. Brandt at White Center, Wa. They resided at Olympia, Wa until John was discharged from the army when, in 1947, they moved to the Brandt family farm near Douglas, Wa. Her husband died in 1975, but she remained on the farm until 1990 when she moved to Waterville.

Ethel was a life-long, member of the Lutheran church, currently United Lutheran in Waterville. She was active in Mary Martha circle, community sewing club, Grange, 4-H leader and Sunday School teacher. She also enjoyed her large family and traveling.
