Evelyn B. Marr, 96, of Wenatchee, passed away on Monday, October 13, 2014 in Wenatchee. She was born on April 28, 1918 in Wenatchee to James and Elsie (Somerville) Jensen. She graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1936 and attended Wenatchee Business College. Evelyn was a bookkeeper for Douglas County Auditor's Office in Waterville for several years. On August 24, 1941 she married Stanley E. Marr in Wenatchee.

Her whole life was centered around her two sons, James Edward and Stan G. She was a long-time member of the First United Methodist Church, where she was active in Mary Ruth Circle. Evelyn volunteered at the Deaconess Hospital Nurses Training Center and later at Central Washington Hospital.
