



## Florence "Anabelle" Rank

October 6, 1914 - November 19, 2010

Florence "Anabel" Rank, 96, of Wenatchee, passed away on Friday, November 19, 2010. She was born to Charles Freeman and Nella Matilda (Calder) Anderson on October 6, 1914, in Bremerton, WA. In 1933, Anabel graduated from Bremerton High School. She attended Business College in Seattle. On April 8, 1944, she married Carroll P. Rank and in 1945 they moved to Cashmere. She was a lifelong member of several charity groups, including Daughter's of the Nile, DAR, PEO, White Shrine, Alpha Gamma Chapter of Phi Sigma Alpha Sorority and Astral Chapter OES of Wenatchee. Also she volunteered at the Red Cross Blood Bank. Anabel was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church and St. James Episcopal Church in Cashmere.
