He went to school at St John's Cathedral High School. He then served in the US Navy and was honorably discharged after 4 years. He was on the USS Coral Sea as an Aircraft Structural Mechanic during the Viet Nam War. He and his family moved to Leavenworth, WA. in 1970, where he had worked at Aplets and Cotlets and then Peshastin/Cashmere Lumber Mills, where he was a road grader operator. After the closure of the lumber mills, he went to work for Cashmere Manufacturing in Cashmere and East Wenatchee, where he enjoyed making parts for the Boeing jets. 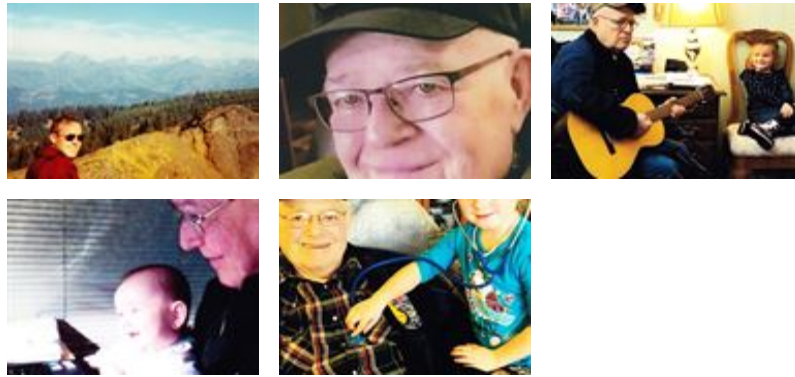
