I worked in the gift shops at the St Louis Cathedral and Old Ursuline Convent in New Orleans. He would ordered a medal of the Bessed Mother. A week or two later he called back for another one. I recognized his distinct voice and asked if he had lost the first one I had sent. He was very happy that I had remembered him. He hadn't lost the first one, he had given it away to someone that needed it. He was so pleased with how it made that person feel he said he needed to keep some in his pocket. He would call every couple of weeks and we would talk for as long as I could. Tulane University, apples, weather, which cemetery his mom was in were some of our many discussions. I sent him a keychain flashlight for when his winter walks took longer than he expected. He said he wasn't sure if he was walking slower, if his mind would wander or both.
