George A. Moore Junior passed away at the age of 98. He was born September 21, 1926 in Wenatchee to George Sr. and Alice Moore.

George was educated in the Wenatchee school system graduating from high school in 1944. He joined the navy soon after his graduation and became a navy medical corpsman serving in World War II. Upon his discharge he joined his father in the orchard business.

In 1948, he married his high school sweetheart, Shirley Whitbeck. He built their home on the family orchard on Castlerock Avenue, where they resided for 68 years before Shirley's passing. They were blessed in their marriage with two wonderful children, Timothy Moore and Roxanne (Moore) Hawkins. In addition to his work at the orchard, he worked as an orchard field man for Chamberlin Agriculture. George was also a charter volunteer member of Chelan County Fire District #1 serving for over 20 years. He retired from service as a volunteer Assistant Chief. Additionally, he served as the fire district commissioner and board member for the Washington Fruit Growers Association.

Upon retirement, George and Shirley enjoyed their membership in the Leavenworth Golf Club. Retirement also provided an opportunity to travel in their motorhome, touring much of the US including an extended trip down the East Coast. They enjoyed cruises on both the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans. They spent their winters in their home in the Palm Springs area of Southern California for over 27 years where they were active in their lovely gated community. During their time there, the Board of Directors created a special award to recognize their outstanding service to the park.

George was preceded in death by his parents, wife Shirley, and son Timothy. He is survived by daughter Roxanne Hawkins (Bruce), Daughter in law Sherry Moore, 3 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren.
