Grace N. (Lowry) Clausen, 92, a longtime resident of Cashmere, was peacefully called home to be with Jesus on Wednesday, October 12, 2016. Grace fought the good fight and won the battle. She had resided at Epledalen Assisted living for the last 6 years.

Grace was born in a little farm house outside Wallace, South Dakota, September 7th, 1924 to Albert and Mabel (Bale) Lowry. The family moved to Watertown, South Dakota and she became quite the city girl. This was until she met the love of her life, Wayne B. Clausen in 1942. She graduated from Watertown High School in 1942. Wayne and Grace married October 24th, 1943 and she became a farmer's wife leaving her city apparel behind. Not only did she live on a dairy farm, she raised 200 chickens every year, gathered the eggs and then sold them. She was so proud she had earned enough egg money to buy her daughter, Carla, an accordion. Grace was a yodeler and sang country music in local talent shows, a poet and performed in many skits; she was quite the entertainer. She was a charter member in the American Lutheran Church in Castlewood, South Dakota as well as a Sunday school teacher, and a member of the Ladies Aid.

Wayne, Grace and Carla moved to Cashmere, Washington in 1960. She then became an active member of the Grace Lutheran Church in Cashmere. She was known around the neighborhood for taking all the children to Sunday

school. She cooked and baked for anyone who became ill and was in need. She volunteered as a Grey Lady at the Cashmere Convalescent Center and Reach to Recovery for American Cancer Society following her winning battle with breast cancer. She was also a charter member of the Wacoka Kiwanis Club. Grace was a wonderful lady, mother, grandmother, great grandma (Ol' Gramma), great-great grandmother and Godmother.
