Beginning in 1986 I worked closely with Allan at the state office of the Farmers Home Administration in Wenatchee. I was appointed by the Reagan administration to be the State Director and Allan was the Human Resources administrator.

For the next seven years Allan advised me on many personal issues. I learned a lot from this experience and greatly gained a strong appreciation for the men and women who were civil servants.
