Harold G Moore 89, of Wenatchee passed away September 6, 2011 at Central Washington Hospital. He was born on April 13, 1922 to Notie Surber and Otto Moore in Rector Arkansas. Harold enlisted in the United States Army in 1942 where he served in the A.P. Theater of Operations as a Combat Infantryman. His job was driving ammunition vehicles through combat areas in black out conditions for extended periods at of time. While on duty in the Pacific Harold was awarded the WWII victory ribbon, good conduct medal, A.P. theater ribbon, two bronze service stars, Philippine liberation ribbon and a bronze star .Harold ended his duty in 1945 returning back to Memphis Tennessee to work at Ford Motor Company on an assembly line making cars. He then met the love of his life Ometa Heflin, who he married in 1947 in Desoto Co. Mississippi. Together they had three children Jannette, Danny (deceased) and Rita. Harold moved his family to Wenatchee in 1962 where he could be closer to his sister Dorothy Moore of Malaga. After settling in the Wenatchee area Harold began working for Wenatchee Golf and Country Club until he retired in 1984. Harold enjoyed taking his wife to church every Sunday at Wenatchee Valley Baptist church. Together they made time for their grandchildren and great-grandchildren, taking them to church and for ice cream every chance they got. When Harold wasn't with his family, he enjoyed long bike rides, working on automobiles and reminiscing old times with friends over coffee. Harold touched many lives and will be missed by many, but especially his family who he sculpted into responsible loving people.
