Ina O. Anderson, age 102, passed away on Friday, March 15, 2019, in her home in Wenatchee, WA. Ina was born on December 15, 1916, in Berthoud, CO, to Ira and Jessi Hankins. She attended school in Colorado and graduated from the University of Wyoming with a teaching degree at age 18, and obtained a Masters Degree in Special Education from Michigan State University. Over the years, she held a number of teaching jobs ranging from a one-room school house, teaching photography to members of the military in Alaska, to finally teaching American Dependent children overseas in Ethiopia, Turkey, Korea, Portugal, and Italy for the last 18 years of her career. While in Alaska, Ina met and married Terrell James "Andy" Anderson. They were married on June 2, 1945, and divorced 25 years later.

She led a life full of adventure and travel and knew how to enjoy life. She travelled the world, she loved to go fishing and camping and even bought herself a new car at age 100. Her strength, pride, and determination were inspirational.
