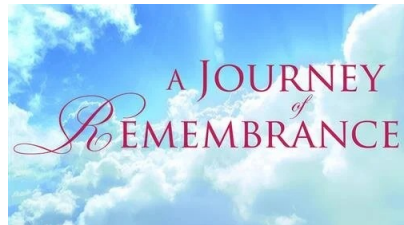
Jim never met a stranger. He loved to talk and make people laugh. He was a devoted husband and father.

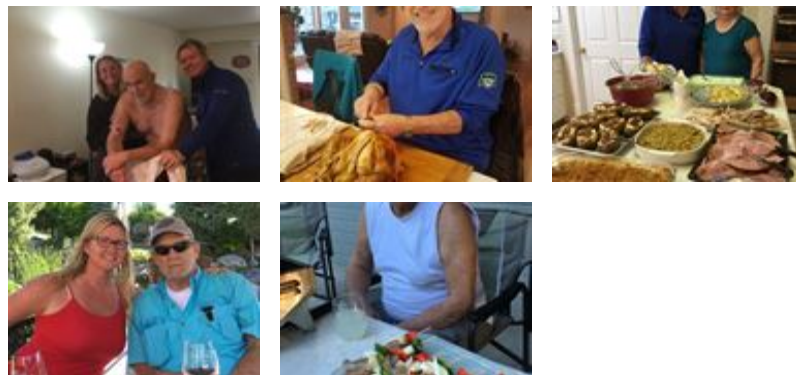
