Jean Shotwell, a former resident of Wenatchee and Leavenworth, died February 17 in Bellevue, Washington. Jean was born in Valier, Montana, on April 20, 1914, to Carleton and Esther Field who moved to Leavenworth in 1918. Jean graduated from Leavenworth High School and briefly attended Washington State University. She worked for the Peshastin Fruit Growers' Association as a bookkeeper after college.

On May 21, 1941, Jean married Ralph L. Shotwell, Jr., of Wenatchee. After World War II, the couple moved to Spokane where Ralph was a founding partner of the Showacre, Coons, Shotwell, Adams Advertising Agency and Jean was a volunteer for the Spokane Symphony.

In 1990 the Shotwells returned to East Wenatchee. They were members of the Wenatchee Golf and Country Club until they moved to the Seattle area in 2006.
