Her life began on December 20, 1924 in Sandon, British Columbia. She was the third girl born to James and Martha Allison. She spent her childhood in Stehekin, Washington. Jean graduated from Chelan High School in 1942. After graduating from the North Central Bible Institute in St. Paul, Minnesota in 1945, she married Ernest Paul Sjoberg in 1946, who she met at college. Together they became missionaries to the Philippines shortly after the end of WWII. While it was an extremely difficult time with many cultural and financial challenges, they successfully started many churches on the island of Luzon and several on the island of Mindanao. The biggest church is in Angeles City, Pampanga province on the island of Luzon. It is called the Calvary Temple. She retired from missionary work in 1973. She settled in Entiat, Washington so she could be close to her childhood home in Chelan, Washington. She learned to sort apples and retired from working when she was 77 years old. She was an extraordinary woman. She was faithful to Jesus for her entire life. She loved reading and studying the Bible. Her love for her family was intense and she never ceased to provide and support all those whom she loved while she was able. She gave without reservation. She loved to play the piano and organ. She crocheted, sewed, refurnished furniture and was good at building things. One of her greatest joys was gardening. She loved flowers and turned her home into a beautiful oasis with beauty everywhere. She went to be with Jesus, her Lord and Savior, on April 5, 2017. A memorial

of her life will be held at the Entiat Warehouse Church on April 13, 2017 at 1pm. She is survived by her 3 children, 7 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.

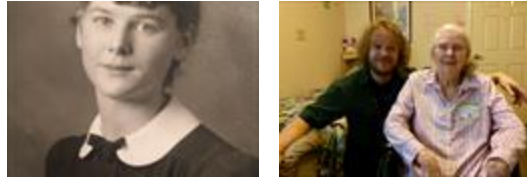
