John Darwin Bayne, 89, passed away peacefully at his home on May 29, 2021. John was born on January 9, 1932 in Leavenworth, WA to Fayven and Gladys Bayne. He attended Leavenworth High School until he enrolled in the Navy with his brother Bob in 1950. He served on the USS Chevalier during the Korean war until 1954. While on leave from the Navy John married the love of his life Deloris (Shirley) Radke in 1951.

After his honorable discharge, John and Shirley lived in Leavenworth on the family homestead up the Icicle. They moved to Wenatchee in 1960 where they raised their 3 children, John (Trina), Ron (Mary), and Julie (Dennis). John's hobbies included fishing, hunting, camping, snowmobiling, and motorcycle riding with his kids and grandkids. He spent many happy summers by his swimming pool with his family. He was known for taking meticulous care of his lawn and garden. During their retirement years John and Shirley held special places in their hearts for their dogs Sam, Nellie I, and Nellie II.
