January 20, 1920 - January 8, 2013

John Dewey Dissmore, 92, of Salam, Virginia, passed away Tuesday, January 8, 2013. He was born on January 20, 1920 in Entiat, Washington, the son of Dewey and Ethel Dissmore.

He graduated from Entiat High School in 1939. He was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Eighth Air Force in Kimbolton, England. He graduated from WSU with a degree in Agricultural Economics and spent many years working with the Farmers Home Administration in the Okanogan and Wenatchee Valleys. He also worked in the national office in Washington, D.C. for a year in 1973. The Dissmores moved to Roanoke, Virginia, in August 2005.

As a young man, John made his choice to serve the Lord at a Chelan Convention. He was faithful to that choice to the end. A great source of joy to him was having a Sunday morning meeting in his home for many years.

He is survived by his wife of 70 years, Lucile (Culver) Dissmore; two sons and daughter-in-laws, Ray and Linda Dissmore of Everett, WA., and Tim and Susan Dissmore, of Federal Way, WA., one daughter and son-in-law, Carol and Wayne Snyder, of Daleville, Virginia; five grandchildren, Jared Snyder, Cindy (Stewart) Davis, Blake Matthews, Justin Dissmore and Charlotte Dissmore, two great-grandsons, Carson and Kellen Davis; and a brother, Lael Dissmore, of Wenatchee.
