On his 18th birthday he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served for 15 months before being discharged at the end of WWII.

He met and married Louise Lias Henley while working as a production illustrator for Boeing. They were married in March of 1959. John worked the bulk of his career in retail sales. He managed the JC Penney store in Port Townsend as well as Zitting Department Store's in Ellensburg and Wenatchee. A stint selling Chrysler products for Valley Auto Co., Wenatchee earned him the nickname, "Honest John".

He was an active and faithful member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints and served diligently in a number positions including Bishop of the Wenatchee First Ward..
