John A. Jackson, 75, passed away on Friday, October 15, 2010. he was born on September 4, 1935 in Wenatchee to James and Solia (Caudil) Jackson.

He enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in 1955 and served in California, Alaska, Florida and Viet Nam, retiring as Staff Sergeant in 1955. He then returned to Wenatchee where he worked for Vans Garden Center for 5 years.
