John and his parents moved to Oroville, WA in 1944, where John graduated from Oroville High School in 1945. He joined the Navy after graduating and was stationed in Oklahoma and in the San Francisco area. He was in the Photography Department and became quite good at his job. After being married to his first wife, Donna, and leaving the Navy, they moved back to Oroville, WA, where John learned to become a Meat Cutter. He worked for Safeway and Redlinger's in Wenatchee for a short time. They then moved down to California, where he worked for 30 years before retiring and moving back up to Wenatchee in 1984. He worked for Merchant Police and KB Alloys Security until retiring. John was very active in an international club that shared music and conversation by way of cassette tapes. John had a large collection of records to rely on. He was a Cameraman and an Editor for Senior TV, aka Twin Rivers TV, where he was very popular and active. John is survived by his wife, Sylvia, of the home; and four surviving daughters; along with many grandchildren.
