John L. "Jack" Shreve passed away peacefully of natural causes January 2, 2012, at the age of 93. Born in Wenatchee on May 18, 1918, to Lewis and Carolyn Shreve, Jack resided most of his life in the city where he was born. After graduating from Wenatchee High School, Jack completed his formal education in Seattle, WA at the University of Washington, where he received his BS in Electrical Engineering. After graduation, Jack married Dorothea M. Crockett and raised a family of three children. Jack's first job after graduation was with the Bonneville Power Administration as a Junior Electrical Engineer. In 1947, Jack left BPA to become the first employee of the Chelan County PUD, where he served in various capacities as Chief Engineer, Director of Distribution, Sales Manager and Operations Director. In 1969, he served as the Director General of Wenatchee Apple Blossom Association. From 1972 to 1983, Jack supervised the drafting of recreation master plans for the District's Rock Island, Rocky Reach and Lake Chelan hydroelectric projects. He retired from the Chelan

County PUD in 1983. Starting in January of 1987, Jack served a six year term on the Parks and Recreation Commission.

Jack was preceded in death by his wife, Dorothea; and is survived by his three children, Diana Dailey, Peter Shreve and John Shreve; three grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren; as well as his wife, Betty G. Shreve.
