



## Justin Schroeder

September 4, 1960 - April 24, 2016

Justin K. Schroeder, 55, passed away peacefully at home in Wenatchee on Sunday April 24, 2016. He was born on September 4, 1960 and is oldest of five children of Justin and Helen Schroeder. He attended Wenatchee High School where he played football and graduated in 1979. He went on to play football at Wenatchee Valley College and later attended Hillsdale College and Central Washington University. Justin spent his younger years working at the family business and orchard. Later he worked in construction and mining throughout the United States and returned to Wenatchee five years ago. He is preceded in death by his father and brother Sean. 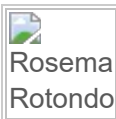
