



Kathleen R. Hendrickson

August 30, 1930 - December 27, 2014

Kathleen Rae (Corrick) Hendrickson was born August 30, 1930 in Walker Minnesota to Marshall and Hazel Corrick. She was the second of eight children. Although her family lived in the Peshastin area during the war, they spent most of her childhood at the family farm near Laporte, Minnesota, where she graduated from Laporte High School.

She married her grade school sweetheart Duane Hendrickson in 1949. Their daughter, Diana was born in Minnesota and daughter, Terry in North Dakota. The family moved to Wenatchee in 1956 where they later had their son, Lee.

Kathleen was a homemaker, Sunday school teacher, and groundskeeper at Garden Terrace. She also worked in a number of local orchards thinning and picking. Although she was petite in frame she was very capable moving a ladder, filling her apple bag, tending a garden, mowing the lawn, painting the house, refinishing antiques, setting up a camp site, baking cinnamon rolls and in later years becoming an accomplished artist. In addition to her three children Kathleen was blessed with five grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren.

Her relationship with Christ led her to be an integral part of both the Wenatchee First Baptist and Wenatchee Free Methodist churches where she taught first grade Sunday school for more than 40 years collectively.

On Saturday, December 27th Kathleen joined the coffee and doughnut time in Heaven with those that preceded her: parents Hazel and Marshall as well as her brothers Lee, Delmar, Clarence, and Richard and great-grandson Richard. She is survived by her husband, Duane; brothers, Marshall Jr and Michael; and sister, Donnie. She will be sorely missed here on earth by her family, friends, and all whose lives she touched.
