Kenneth Lloyd Zielke went to be with the Lord on July 2, 2011. Ken was born to Edna and John Zielke in Dodge City, KS on December 2, 1936. In December of 1954, he joined and proudly served in the United States Air Force, where, after serving, he was honorably discharged. He then worked for the U.S. Forest Service in Chelan and Leavenworth until 1983, when he went to Long Hauling the 48 states for 11 years, with his wife. Ken's hobby was a love of racing his cars in the local race tracks. In 1994, he had a water tender built and contracted on fires with the U.S. Forest Service, until he retired in 2002. Ken was a member of the Assembly of God Church (Riverwalk Church).

Ken is survived by his wife, Julie Zielke, of the home; two brothers, Clair Zielke (Val) of Yuma, AZ and Keith Zielke (Margie) of Brewster; and one sister, Winona Burbridge (Larry) of Wenatchee.
