Larry Jordan passed away peacefully at his home in Wenatchee on January 25, 2015, surrounded by his family. Larry was born in Waterville, WA and raised on his family's farm in Withrow, WA. He graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1952, then served in the US Army at Fort Lewis for two years before being honorably discharged.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Gloria Bringedahl Jordan; three children, Dan (Gail) Jordan, Carrie Jordan (Rick Leonard), and Jackie (Mark) Tsutakawa; two grandchildren, Kaitlyn Tsutakawa and Megan Tsutakawa; and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, George and Mary Jordan; and eight siblings, Amelia (Mitchell), Herman, Edward, Helen (died in infancy), Ervin, Emanuel, Elvin and Bob Jordan.
