



Lloyd C. Ogle

May 29, 1921 - February 1, 2013

Lloyd Charles Ogle, 91, of Wenatchee, passed away on Friday, February 1, 2013. He was born on May 29, 1921 at Waterville to Charles V. and Ruth (Rankin) Ogle on a farm one mile west of Waterville. Lloyd graduated from Waterville High School in 1939. He worked for Webb Tractor and Equipment in 1940, and entered the U. S. Navy in June of 1942. He served with P. T. Boats in the Aleutian Islands and then with AD. COM.PHIBS. PAC. in Guam. Lloyd served as Chief Petty Officer until honorably discharged in December 1945. He worked for the Waterville Auto Company on July 1, 1946 as Shop Foreman for 37 years. He retired in 1983.

He married Elva H. Vetter in 1947, and was later divorced. He then married Flossie F. McCulley in 1964 at Wenatchee.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife of 35 years; three brothers; three sisters; one son and one step-daughter. He is survived by two daughters, Daphne (Ogle) Calkins of Page, Arizona and Christy (Ogle) Hill of Wenatchee; five grandchildren; six great grandchildren.
