Louisa "Lou" M. Shaffer, 91, passed away on Monday, September 10, 2012 at her home in Wenatchee. She was born on July 7, 1921 to Frank and Dolly Wayman in Benton, Illinois. She attended school in Benton, graduating from Benton High School in 1941.

On October 26, 1941, she married Virgil Shaffer in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. They lived in Benton, Illinois, where they raised their four daughters. Lou worked for U.S. Soil Conservation Service in Benton for five years, and then the family moved to St. Louis where she was employed at McDonnell – Douglas Aerospace as an engineering release clerk for 25 years, retiring in 1987.
