Lovelle Ann Jeffris was born in Wenatchee, WA on October 11, 1929 to Orval and Maisie (Lake) Newsham. She joined two sisters, Irma and Frankie. Later a younger brother, Bruce joined the family. Lovelle grew up in Cashmere, WA, graduating from CHS in 1947. On June 27, 1947, she married Jerry Jeffris and they made their home in Peshastin, WA.

Lovelle was employed at Peshastin Fruit Growers (Blue Bird) for many years. In 1964, Jerry and Lovelle purchased their first orchard, adding acreage in later years. Lovelle was active in the Peshastin United Church of Christ, the Peshastin - Dryden Float Committee, and the community council over the years. Four sons were added during her 65 year marriage, and she became active in school activities throughout their education years.

Lovelle was preceded in death by her parents, sisters, brother, and her husband, Jerry in 2012. She is survived by her sons, Gary (Denise) of Cashmere, Jeff (Christina) of Malaga, Christopher of East Wenatchee, and Mike (Karen) of Peshastin.
