



## Lucille Anne Worth

February 15, 1920 - January 6, 2011

Lucille 'Lucy' Anne Worth, 90, of Coulee City, Washington, passed away on January 6, 2011. She was born February 15, 1920 in Oakland, CA. Lucy was an only child and lost her father when she was just 16. Lucy made her family out of classmates, band members, friends and neighbors.

In 1955 she married Russell 'Steve' Worth and his family became her own. After Lucy's son Sam married his wife Rose, her parents and brother became a big part of her life as well. Everybody was considered family to her and she was known to many as 'Grandma Lucy'.

She never learned to drive so she walked everywhere. She even walked from her house to the Laundromat 3 miles away – with laundry. She walked to her job at Newberys, and everywhere in Coulee City. As her knees became a problem as she got older, she rarely complained. And while she never liked having to use a wheelchair, if it meant she got to go somewhere, she'd put up with it.

Lucy was a social butterfly and hated to be stuck at home and not able to go out to breakfast, Church, karaoke, or lunch at the senior center. She also enjoyed people coming to see her; bringing her the mail, doing her nails, watching a baseball game with her on T.V., bringing her meals, delivering her groceries, helping her decorate for the seasons or helping her with housekeeping.

Assisted Living was out of the question for Lucy, but with the many friends that helped her, she had the perfect Assisted Living situation. This made her dream of staying in her home possible.

Mrs. Worth didn't talk badly about others; always felt someone deserved a second chance. She accepted people for who they were, and hoped they felt that ways towards her. She was generous, kind, friendly, and had a wonderful sense of humor.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, January 15, 2011 at the First Presbyterian Church of Coulee City at 12:00pm.
