Manuel Torres Corona, 76, passed away on Monday, March 9, 2015 in Wenatchee, WA. He was born on December 28, 1938 in Mexico. He resided in Jocotepec, and Chquilistlan Jalisco, Mexico. In 1961 he became a resident of the United States and lived in California. In 1983 he moved to Entiat, where he managed orchards. In 1992 he became a proud citizen of the United States. In 1993 he moved to Omak to fulfill his long dream of owning and operating his own orchard, where he received awards for his quality apples that he grew. He was an example of the "American Dream." Due to illness he moved to Wenatchee in 2010, where he fought a courageous battle with cancer.

He is survived by his loving wife, Victoria Torres of 54 years and eight children, Agustin Torres, Jose Torres, Roberto Torres, Carmen Leal, Jose Manuel Torres, Maria Guzman, Juan Torres and Alma Torres; 25 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren.

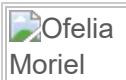
