Marion Yvonne Baskin was born on September 1, 1939. She went home to Heaven, Sunday, August 28, 2016.

Marion attended Green River Community College in Auburn where she got her two year degree and became a Licensed Practical Nurse.

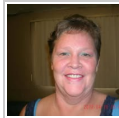
