Michael Jones, 67, died of a heart-attack at home on Saturday, April 14th, in Wenatchee, WA. He was born August 10, 1944 in Niles (MI), graduated from Lake Washington High School in 1962, and attended Bob Jones University. At the time of his death, he was the north-central Washington director for Child Evangelism Fellowship, overseeing gospel outreach through Good News Clubs in towns throughout the region. Mike enjoyed traveling, Dulcimer festivals, and singing.

He is survived by his sons, Phillip Harter (MI) and Mark Jones (PA); his mother, Betty Anne Lassiter, and step-father, Tom Lassiter (Mansfield, WA); sisters, Paula Lassiter (Seattle, WA) and Helen Ray (IN); and and brothers, Phillip Steyeart (IN) and John Jones (MI). A memorial service will be held at the Jones and Jones - Betts Funeral Home in Wenatchee, WA, at 2:00PM on Saturday, April 21st, with a prior viewing from noon to 1:30.
