Mildred Rose was born in Manus, Missouri November 14, 1929. She was the first of four children born to Arthur and Fern Todd. The Great Depression was on and the family moved across the country, looking for jobs. They landed in the Northwest first, then finally made their way back to Central Washington, where they found a home in Monitor. Millie grew up in Monitor and attended High School in Cashmere. She married Varian Lumberg in Monitor in 1948. They moved to Coulee Dam and Varian worked on building the dam. In June 1948 Millie gave birth to a daughter, Christine. Shortly Millie, Varian and Christine moved back to Monitor where Varian and Millie built the first house they owned.

Millie worked at Sears and Roebuck, downtown in Wenatchee for several years where she became manager of the Catalog Department. In 1963 the family moved to Sunnyslope. Millie was Aunt to several nieces and nephews. She hosted many family get togethers through the years. She was loved by many friends, family, and neighbors.

Millie was widowed in 1989. She truly lost the one great love of her life. She continued living in Sunnyslope at the same house she and Varian had built together, until she passed at Central Washington Hospital from a short illness, September 17, 2016.
